Hi Dorothy,

...

I did request an update from the Ministry of Energy, prior to the AGM, with regard to the proposed Greenfields power plant on the Lorelands site (which was subsequently "post-mailed" to your home).

The memo simply states:

- After a number of appeals, the Minister of the Environment confirmed the completion of the environmental assessment process in July, 2008.
- The Ministry of the Environment issued the Certificate of Approval in December, 2008.
- The contract between Greenfield South Power Corporation and the Ontario Power Authority was renegotiated as a result of approvals delays. The commercial operation date was moved from 2009 to the third quarter of 2012.
- The company has informed the OPA that it will be in a position to finalize its financing once some remaining issues related to connection to the grid are resolved.
- Although the company claims that their financial state is positive, that has not yet been indicated to the OPA or to the Ministry of Energy.

I am also coordinating meetings to ensure that action is taken on the recommendations submitted by the AQTF report. I agree that a pilot AMS should be established in the Clarkson-Oakville Airshed, I'll keep pressing!

Dear Charles: The many RAs in MIRANET (particularly in Mississauga South) were very pleased that you came out to last night's MIRANET AGM and heard the various reports, including that of the 2010 Clean Air Subcommittee which was delivered by Brian Holtham.

...

We noted that the comments Brian made about the Sherway (Loreland Ave.) power plant caught the attention of yourself and the Mayor, and as requested in person at your office last week (by Sue Shanly and myself) we would appreciate any update concerning the status of the Greenfield South (Eastern Power) site and the intentions of the Energy Minister, who did say in his Oct. 7, 2010 Press Release that no new plant was needed in this area. We still have posted on our website the [Letter: October 7, 2010](#) from then-Councillor Carmen Corbasson

re the planned 280MW power plant, requesting that it be cancelled. While the plant may not be technically within the riding of Mississauga South, it does affect the health of the surrounding residents.

If you have further clarification of Minister Duguid's remarks regarding the possibility of dangerous gas-fired power plants elsewhere in the GTA, please allow us to correct this information on our website -- we currently have interpreted his remarks from Oct. 7, 2010 as meaning no new gas plant anywhere in the GTA (i.e. near people).

You will have also heard Brian's emphasis in his Clean Air report that the Province establish a pilot AMS project in the Clarkson-Oakville Airshed, further to the Action Plan of the AQTf
