AND WHEREAS that Council dissolve the Integrity Nominating Committee and that its mandate be included in the Governance Committee and that the following members; Carlson, Crombie, Fonseca and Saito and Tovey be appointed to the Committee;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Council establish a Governance Committee and that it prepare a Terms of Reference with the mandate to examine issues including, but no limited to, the role of the Integrity Commissioner, ethics, lobbying, the Code of Conduct, and election financing, be approved.
